Over 500 Refugee Neighbors, Volunteers, Students & Children Gathered This Summer

Our 6-session Summer Program included fun for everyone in the family! We celebrated different cultures, enjoyed meals together. We had programs specific for adults, students, children, and kids with special needs. Middle and high school students from around the world volunteered, along with many adults in our community.



THREE Buses Needed for EVERY Program

Many of our refugee neighbors want to join our program, they just don't have a ride. We began by chartering one bus in 2022; this summer our THREE buses picked up neighbors in St Charles, Geneva, Batavia, North Aurora, Aurora, and Montgomery. We made a promise to our neighbors: We will come for you!



Translation Technology Helps Everyone Understand

When a refugee neighbor arrived at our Summer Program, our staff and volunteers equipped them with an ipad and headphones. Then they toggled to 1 of 63 languages. As English was

spoken into the microphone, the words were translated live into many languages, including Russian, Spanish, Swahili, French, and Farsi. For the very first time, many of our neighbors could engage in the presentations shared at Radical Love because they could understand what was being said. At Radical Love, we are working to build bridges in our community, and the very first step to doing that is to understand one another.

Since we began in 2021, we have impacted over 20,000 lives including refugees, children, low-income senior citizens, and volunteers.

Adults

We brought in speakers to help our adult neighbors learn about budgeting, planning for the future with money, building strong relationships, and internet safety. Adults then chose a learning track and practiced English.





Childcare & Special Needs

More than 75 children ages 5 and under were cared for this year. And we held a special program for children with special needs so that every refugee family wanting to attend had a place.

In April of this year, Radical Love gave an All-School assembly at Geneva High School. Three refugee neighbors shared their stories with 1600 high school students. More than 150 students joined Radical Love following the assembly and many came to help this summer!

The Summer Program culminated with our annual Beach Day at Batavia Quarry, where we swam, played volleyball, enjoyed pizza and cotton candy, and celebrated a summer of community!



Radical Love Bracelets

Every participant this summer received a Radical Love bracelet, which honored the late Pastor Amos Shakya (pastor of the local Nepali church), who died of a heart attack in May at age 40. This was the verse shared at Amos' funeral and what he spent his life sharing:

"For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." - Romans 8:39-39. The verse was simplified for our bracelets:

Nothing can separate us from the love of Jesus.

Priscila entered her junior year at a local university; the scholarship will cover her books and supplies.

The evening brought together 250 neighbors, who worked to raise over \$136,000 for Radical Love! We had over 30 silent auction baskets, and a live auction that included 12 couples winning trips to Greece! Woven into the night were powerful stories and beautiful music by our refugee neighbors.
